Control no.	Existing control measures or factors to reduce risk (Control 1 refers to risk 1 above)
1	<p>Vessel crew to follow steps within Method Statement ensuring risk of COVID-19 spread is minimized to as low as reasonably practicable ALARP. Contact with passengers and other crew will be kept to a minimum. Where social distancing guidance is not fully achievable, relevant PPE will be used. Health monitoring will be followed, and health declaration form to be completed prior to each shift.</p> <p>Should symptoms for COVID-19 appear whilst on duty, vessel should return to a safe berth at earliest opportunity and crew to take measures for medical support as per government guidelines.</p>
2	<p>Passengers to follow guidance from vessel crew.</p> <p>Details of seating arrangements, boarding vessel and safety induction will be given verbally from a safe distance.</p> <p>Social distancing and government guidance will be followed and updated according to the latest information.</p> <p>Passenger health declarations will form part of the online disclaimer and boarding of vessel will only be allowed when completed.</p> <p>Passengers to be allocated seats prior to boarding.</p> <p>Safety induction will be provided verbally before boarding. This will include how to board, where to sit, safety instructions for the voyage and how to exit the vessel.</p>

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Control no.	Existing control measures or factors to reduce risk (Control 1 refers to risk 1 above)
3	<p>Vessel will be fully cleaned prior to any voyages taking place and also once completed. If multiple voyages are undertaken within the same day, cleaning will be undertaken between each voyage.</p> <p>All persons will have access to hand sanitizer before boarding the vessel and also prior to disembarking.</p> <p>Specific entry and exit points to the vessel will be given in the safety induction.</p> <p>Crew will wear PPE in accordance with company policy</p> <p>All hand hold areas and seats will be disinfected thoroughly after each use.</p>
4	<p>All voyages to be pre planned. On the day booking will not be undertaken in person. Bookings via online system only to ensure minimum face to face contact. Persons arriving for voyages will be given instruction on where to wait insuring social distancing is maintained. If other operators are utilizing the same areas (Harbour wall), passengers and crew will only transit to and from the vessel when access route is clear of other people. Safe distancing will be marked out as required to show persons how social distancing can be maintained.</p> <p>As voyages might take place from differing locations, these steps will be implemented each time.</p>
